At Trinity we recognize the importance of athletics and extra-curricular activities for a well rounded educational experience.

Beginning in middle school, Trinity offers teams for the following sports:

- Cross Country
- Volleyball
- Boys and Girls Basketball
- Track

Prior to middle school, students are encouraged to play on Trinity teams that are facilitated by the Parks and Recreation Department.

Each year in February, our 5th-8th graders are invited to participate in the Lutheran Elementary Schools Tournament (LEST). This tournament allows our students to experience competition at a very high level with other Lutheran schools from 6 different states! Our teams can compete in the following:

Extra-curricular activities also make up an important part of the Trinity experience. Our students have the opportunity to be a part of: Chess Club, Lego Robotics Club, Choir, Ensemble, Gate keepers (student led worship team), Band, Handbells, Student Council, Christmas programs and musicals.

Student talent is featured during several special events throughout the year. These have included Christmas programs, musical productions, concerts, Celebrate our Schools Night, 2nd grade pilgrim play, 4th grade Oregon Trail play, 5th grade state fair presentation and 6th-High School spring musical presentations.

Our students also look forward to a variety of field trips beginning at Kindergarten. Trips for Kindergarten - 3rd grade include: The Pumpkin Patch, High Desert Museum, Wizard Falls Fish Hatchery, and Richardson's Rock Ranch. Students in 4th grade supplement their study of Oregon history with a trip to Fort Vancouver and the State Capital. Fifth graders take an overnight trip to the Oregon Coast. Sixth grade and seventh grade have gone on overnight trips to Portland and Seattle. Eighth grade trips have included an overnight trip to Ashland for the Shakespearean Festival.
