Grade Level: 9 - 10

Prerequisite: None

Course Duration: Two Semesters

Subject Area in which graduation credit is given:

World Language

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Spanish I is beginning level Spanish. This introductory course gives students the opportunity to learn about Spanish speaking countries, people, and their cultures. The basic grammar and vocabulary will help students communicate with each other as well as native speakers. Students will read, write, hear and speak Spanish daily in class.

Spanish II

Grade Level: 9 - 10

Course Duration: Two Semesters

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Spanish II is designed to build on the content knowledge learned in Spanish I. Vocabulary and grammar continues and advances. Students will be writing and conversing in present, past, and future tenses. Students will read short stories and Bible passages throughout the year to ensure solid comprehension and pronunciation. Students will read, write, hear, and speak Spanish daily in class.

Grade Level: 10-12

Course Duration: Two Semesters

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The third class is a continuation of what has been established in Spanish I and II. Vocabulary and grammar continues and increases. There is a greater emphasis on speaking Spanish in class, reading authentic materials such as newspaper articles or tv news reports. Students will experience using the language in real-life situations as opportunities arise for ministry within the community and outside of the community. The emphasis of this class is to use the language to impact others positively.
