
### A note from the directors

We are so blessed here at Trinity by the generosity and support of our family. Despite the challenges these last couple of years have brought to music and performing arts, we are continuing to find new and creative ways to keep music and the arts in the lives of our students and families. In case you missed



it, here are some links to some of our performances last year, done in many creative ways. We (hopefully) look forward to having a little more of a normal year with in person concerts, musicals, and events but regardless, our staff and students will continue to be innovative and strive for excellence in the arts.
